Article 1

ORGANIZATION

Vuelta Femenina a Costa Rica 2022 is organized by a Costa Rican Cycling Federation Committee -which could be place in San Jose, Mata Redonda, Parque Metropolitano La Sabana, Otilio Ulate Blanco Monument, in front of La Princesa Marina Restaurant. Phone numbers (506) 2231-7814, (506) 2231-3944, (506) 2296-1108 and the fax (506) 2231-4155; email fecoci@fecoci.net

This event will be conducted under the regulations of the Union Cycliste International. It is to be held from Thursday, July 14th to Sunday, July 17th.

The property and the rights of commercial exploitation of this event are exclusive to the Costa Rican Cycling Federation.

Article 2

TYPE OF EVENT

The event is available to teams, according to the Art. 2.1.005 of the UCI Regulations for Women Elite - Under 23 category (WE-WU). The event is entered on the UCI's International Calendar.

The event is registered as a class 2.2. In conformity with the UCI Regulations (Art. 2.10.017), points are awarded as follows:

Article 3

PARTICIPATION

According to the article 2.1.005 of UCI Regulations, this event is available to the following teams:

- a) UCI Women's World Teams (max 3)
- b) UCI Women's Continental Teams
- c) UCI Women's cyclo-cross professional
- d) National Teams **
- e) Clubs or Local Teams **
- f) Mixed Teams **

According to the article 2.2.003 of UCI Regulations, the minimum number of cyclist for each team is four (4) and six (6) maximums. A team cannot participate with less than four (4) riders.

National club teams can strengthen their group with one (1) foreign cyclist maximum, at the same case, the foreign club teams can be reinforce by one (1) national cyclist maximum.

All National Teams or Foreign Club Team wishing to participate must present the letter of Permission from their National Federation, as well as those foreign riders that join local teams, according to Art. 1.2.052

Article 4

ORGANIZATION AND PRESS HEADQUARTERS

Article 5

PREVIOUS MEETINGS

The delivery and installation of communication equipment of Radio Tour and number of authorized vehicle for National Teams will be held July 12th, in the FECOCI's offices, in Schedule from 9:00 am to 12:00 md., in San José, Mata Redonda, La Sabana Metropolitan Park, Otilio Ulate Blanco Monument, in front of La Princesa Marina Restaurant.

The meeting of the press, for the delivery of accreditations and communication equipment, is scheduled for 15:00, July 13th in San José, Mata Redonda, La Sabana Metropolitan Park, Otilio Ulate Blanco Monument, in front of La Princesa Marina Restaurant.

The delivery with motorbikes and drivers will be held July 13th, in the FECOCI's offices, at 13:00.

A mandatory meeting with the PCP, Organization, police, security and people involved in driving vehicles in race will be held, also, July 13th, at 14:00 in the FECOCI's offices.

All the vehicle drivers in the race (motorcyclist, team and press drivers and so on) must have, in addition to their driving license, the license of the Costa Rican Cycling Federation to be admitted in the race, according to the Art. 2.2.035.

Article 6

TECHNICAL MEETINGS

The riders' confirmation as well as the delivery of back numbers and accreditations to team manager or technical director, will be held from 15:00 in July 13th, at San Carlos sport City in Ciudad Quesada.

The Technical Meeting- Sports Directors Meeting, also with the Neutral Assistance drivers -organized according to article 1.2.087 of the UCI Regulations-, with the presence of members of the Commissaries' Panel, will be held at 19:00, at Wednesday, July 13th, 2022, at San Carlos Sport City in Ciudad Quesada.

Article 7

INDIVIDUAL TIME TRIAL ORDER

The departure of the cyclists in the stage of Climbing Individual Time Trial will be made in reverse order of the Individual General Classification, according to article 2.6.023 of the UCI Regulations. The leader of this classification will be the last to start. In any case, the Commissaries' Panel can modify the order, to prevent that two cyclists from the same team from following each other. The interval between each cyclist departure shall be one (1) minute, except for the last ten (10) cyclist starting order, which exit every two (2) minutes.

Cyclists must be submitted to the starting area, 15 minutes before the scheduled time of their departure, for the respective check of their bicycles. The escort vehicles shall display (front windscreen) carry one of the dorsal number of the cyclist that they accompanying.

July 14th to 17th 2022

According to article 2.2.024, in Time Trial, the use of radios or other remote communication media for or with the cyclist is allowed. The transmitter-receiver power used shall not exceed 5 watts. The radius of action of the system will be closed in the space occupied by the race. Its use is reserved for exchanges between cyclist and sports director and between cyclists of the same team.

Both, national and international teams will only be allowed a maximum of 3 following vehicles in the Time Trial.

Note: There will be no feeding allowed in this stage.

Article 8

RADIO TOUR

The information of the race situations will be produced by a Radio Tour media. The transmit frequency will be scheduled by the FECOCI. The transmission equipment will be delivered before the Sports Directors Meeting (Technical Meeting) and some alternative schedules. The transmission will be performed in Spanish and English. For Radio Tour, you will channel 1.

Article 9

NEUTRAL TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

The neutral technical assistance service will be insuring by two (three required per 2.3.016) vehicles provided by SHIMANO. It will be properly equipped with spare bicycles, wheels, and properly sealed bottles of pure water. Participating teams are recommended to providing neutral vehicles with part of their material, to avoid compatibility problems. Those vehicles will be under the instructions of the President of the Commissaires' Panel.

In addition, the organization and SHIMANO will locate a wagon "broom" during each stage of competition, which will always go with the last rider of the race and will be equipped with spare material and food assistance.

Article 10

RACE INCIDENTS AT THE LAST THREE KILOMETERS

In case of a fall, puncture or mechanical incident **-duly noted**- in the last three kilometers of a daily stages online, the injured cyclist or cyclists will be credited with the same time of cyclist or cyclists with who were at the time of the incident. The Commissaires will be award for them, the position where the cyclist passes the finish line, according to the Article 2.6.027 of UCI Regulations.

As a consequence of due to a fall proven in the last three kilometers, one or more cyclists are unable to cross the finish line, she or they will be ranked in last position in the stages and will be credited with time of the cyclist whom was at time of the accident. This article does not apply according to article 2.6.028 of the UCI Regulations, in following stages:

Only in exceptional and unforeseeable force majeure, the Commissaries' Panel may extend the finishing time limits after consultation with the Organizer. For cyclists after the deadline, they are given a second chance by the President of Commissaries' Panel; all the points obtained in the secondary general classifications will be withdrawn, in accordance with article 2.6.32 of the UCI Regulation.

A. INDIVIDUAL GENERAL CLASSIFICATION PER TIMES

It is calculated using the sum of the accumulated time-at every stage-by each cyclist, taking into account the penalties that apply -if someone have. The better qualified will be the cyclist who has totaled less time.

In case of a tie, in this classification, the fractional seconds recorded in the Climbing Individual Time Trial stage will be taken into account for the tie.

In case of a tie again, or if you do not have Individual Time Trial stage, it will use the sum of positions obtained in each stage and, ultimately, to the position obtained in the last stage disputed.

Leader Individual General Classification will wear LILAC jersey:



B. GENERAL CLASSIFICATION OF REGULARITY

For this classification, It will be obtained by the sum of accumulated points in the arrivals of all the stages and intermediate sprints, being the best classified the rider who has more points at total.

- 2. The number of wins in prizes of Intermediate Sprints.
- 3. The best one of Individual General Classification per Times.

The tie-breakers will be in accordance at the same form for the Individual General Classification per Times.



G. DAILY and GENERAL TEAM CLASSIFICATION

The Daily Team Classification is established by the sum of the best individual times of each team.

In the case of equality, the teams will split by the sum of the first places by the first runners in the stage. If equality continues, the teams will be broken by the classification of their best runner in the classification of the stage.

Team General Classification is set by the sum of the three best individual times from each team in all stages. In case of equality, the following criteria will apply until they have tie-breaker:

July 14th to 17th 2022

- 1. Number of first places in the daily team classification.
- 2. Number of second places in the daily team classification, and so on.
- 3. Number of second places in the daily team classification, etc
- 4. By the ranking of your best rider in the individual general ranking

If still a tie, the teams have tie-breaker by the classification of thier best cyclist in the individual general classification. It will be removed from the Team General Classification, which is reduced to less than three cyclists

Cyclist of the Leader team of the Team General Classification will wear yellow numbers.

Article 15

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

The UCI Anti-Doping Control Regulation will be applied entirely in this test.

The anti-doping control awning will be located 75 meters after the finish line.

The notifications for the riders that go to the Anti-doping Control will be announced in the Awards podium, by poster that is installed in that site.

Article 16

AWARDS CEREMONY

According with article 1.2.112 of the UCI Regulations, the following riders must attend, as a mandatory, the official awards ceremony, organized at the end of each stage:

- Daily Winner: White Jersey
- Leader of the Under 23 General Classification: Tourquoise Jersey.
- Leader of the Intermediate Sprint Classification: Red Jersey.
- Leader of the Mountain General Classification: White Pink Spots Jersey.
- Leader of the General Classification by Points: Fuchsia Jersey
- Leader of the Individual General Classification per Times: Lilac Jersey.

The riders will present themselves at the podium in a time limit of maximum ten (10) minutes after his crossing the Finish Line and they must obligatorily wear the full uniform of his team, even, if someone will be the leader carrier of some classification. Once the protocol activities have been completed, those who must do so, may go to the site determined for the Anti-Doping Control, accompanied by their accompany.

July 14th to 17th 2022

The riders have the obligation to appear in the Press Awning, for the respective interviews. Who wears the leader's jersey of any of the categories must do so with the respective leader's jersey.

In addition, for the Climbing Time Trial stage, the **"hot seat"** will be implemented where the three cyclists with the best times and whose names will be announced by the loudspeakers, should take a position in the back panel established for that purpose, until they are replaced by the following cyclists with a better time.

FINAL AWARDS

At the end of this event (last stage), the riders will be mandatory present at podium, also, be:

- Winner of the Stage.
- Top 3 of Under 23 General Classification.
- Top 3 of Intermediate Sprint General Classifications.
- Top 3 of Mountain General Classification.
- Top 3 of General Classification by Points.
- Top 3 of Team General Classification.
- Top 3 of Individual General Classification.

Article 17

FORMAL ACTIVITIES

It is the obligation of the invited teams to participate in the protocol activities programmed by the organization, not participating in them will lead to the exclusion of the team in the event.

Article 18

PENALTIES

The UCI Penalty Scale is the only one applicable, according to the Article 2.12.007 - 3 article and general UCI Regulations.

PARTICULAR REGULATIONS AND GENERAL ASPECTS OF THE ORGANIZATION

TRANSITORIES

The current UCI Cycling Sports Regulations will resolve cases not expected in this Regulation.

RESPONSABILITY

According to the dispositions of articles 1.1.006 and 1.1.022 of the UCI Regulations, all entered riders, all the supporters and the technical staff of the Sports Groups must be insured against any accidents they may suffer during the course of the race and its consequences in terms of civil liability, medical expenses, hospitalization and repatriation to your home.

ADDITIONAL

At the briefing, Sports Directors and Media will be informed that once each race is finished; there will be a special site with hydration for cyclists and amenities for journalists to interview the first three at the race and the leaders of the classifications. This being the **ONLY** place to interview cyclists in a press conference, failure to do so will result in sanctions in fines and loss of prizes to runners and sanctions to the media.

Fines issued to riders governed by the Costa Rican Cycling Federation must be paid directly to the federation.

It is requested from the Organization to the Sport Directors of the paticipating teams, that they communicate to their riders, that in race they do not throw objects to the road in order to respect the environment.

In the same way, containers for the collection of waste will be placed in the places of exit and arrival.
