






PEDREGAL

- 1. 1) For a Continental Title to be disputed and the category to be crowned, it is necessary to have at least 3 countries present per category at the time of starting the respective event. If necessary and with the prior arrangement of the committee of commissioners in charge of the event, categories (age groups) may be grouped in order to comply with this requirement.
- 2. For the Team Relay (XCR): each country may enter only a single team, composed of 1 Men Elite, 1 Women Elite, 1 Men under 23, 1 Men Junior, 1 Women under 23 and 1 Women Junior. However, the following substitutions shall be permissible:
 - Men Elite by Women Elite or Men under 23 or Men Junior or Women under 23 or Women Junior;
 - · Women Elite by Women under 23 or by Women Junior;
 - Men under 23 by Women Elite or Women under 23 or Men Junior;
 - Women under 23 by Women Junior;
 - Men Junior by Women Junior.

Each rider selected must already be entered for the individual downhill, or Olympic cross-country events

- 3. Ages are as of December 31 of the year of the event
- 4. The minimum number of teams for the Team Relay is five. (5). If less than 5 teams are registered for the Team Relay the event will be removed from the schedule and not contested.

PARTICIPANTS

All cyclists in all categories in men and women must have a UCI 2025 license, which must be presented to commissaries at the time of formalizing their registration and retrieve their competition numbers. If the license does not have a photo, you must present an official identification document. If you have it, in addition, for foreign riders im UCI categories (Junior, U23 and Elite), the authorization provided by their corresponding federation will be requested, indicating him or the cyclists with their respective code.



CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP

The clothing will be in accordance with article 1.3.026 to 1.3.034, of the international regulations of the UCI. All cyclists must arrive at the starting point correctly uniformed, with the colors and designs of the jersey that represents their national team.

The use of a helmet and bicycle plate will be mandatory for training and competition.

The use of headphones and/or hands-free is prohibited.

Athletes with pets, children, flags or signs are not accepted on the podium.





REGULATION



Panamerican MTB XCO-XCC-XCR Championship 2025, will be governed by the UCI regulations and sanctions scale for the Mountain Bike discipline, published on the page www.uci.org

The Race Commissaires will reserve the right to apply or not the 80% rule, where the rider who is running slower than 80% of the time of the leader's first lap, will be removed from the competition.

XCR

The team manager must submit the team composition on the form provided to identify the names and categories of the riders making up their team and their start order to the Chief commissaire's panel at date and time set in the official schedule. This start order may not be altered subsequently

The exchange boxes will be allocated based on the results of the team relay event in the preceding continental championships. The order of nations not placed will be determined by drawing lots. The first nation will be installed in box number 1 and so on.

The following substitutions shall be permissible:

- Men Elite by Women Elite or Men under 23 or Men Junior or Women under 23 or Women Junior
- Women Elite by Women under 23 or by Women Junior
- Men under 23 by Women Elite or Women under 23 or Men Junior or Women Junior
- Women under 23 by Women Junior
- Men Junior by Women Junior


DOPING CONTROL

The National Anti-Doping Commission, belonging to the National Sports Institute, was requested to be present at the event for the respective controls under the UCI standard, being possible to apply in all categories, this control will be carried out near the arrival area.

The medical authorities sent for this purpose define the control.

PERMANENCE OFFICE

The permanence office will preferably be in an open space at the same finish line of the circuit, there will be the permanence of the organization's personnel, where the delivery of competition numbers will be carried out, review of licenses for the riders of the UCI categories, will supply general information. If there are changes, they will be notified in advance through Costa Rica Cycling Federation's Social Media (FECOCI).


CIRCUIT DISTANCE




The number of laps will be determined by the UCI Commissaire and will be communicated at the technical congress, where the race time for the Junior categories will be between 1:00 and 1:15 hour and the elites between 1:20 and 1:40.

The starting and finishing area will have a demarcated area for the installation of awnings for the teams, a food stand, mechanics, etc.

To determine the location of the team awnings, they must request it via email panamxcocr25@gmail.com









STARTING LINE AND CALL OF RIDERS

At the meeting of the sports directors or technical congress, the race commissaire will inform how many runners will line up for each starting line. The athletes will be called to the box 15 minutes before their departure time and the order of the start call will be made according to the following:

XCO & XCC-MEN ELITE, WOMEN ELITE, MEN U23, & WOMEN U23

- 1. As per the last published UCI XCO individual ranking.
- 2. Unclassified riders: by random order.

XCO-MEN JUNIOR (17-18), WOMEN JUNIOR (17-18)

- 1. As per the last published UCI XCO junior individual ranking.
- 2. Unclassified riders: by random order

XCO-MASTERS (35+), CADETS (15-16)

1. Random order

TEAM RELAY

1. The exchange boxes will be allocated based on the results of the team relay event in the preceding continental championships. The order of nations not placed will be determined by drawing lots. The first nation will be installed in box number 1 and so on.



FEED / TECHNICAL ZONE

There will be two (2) designated Feed/tech zones that will be located on the course. Feeding and Technical support may only be provided in this Zone. All individuals who are feeding or providing technical support must register with the individual or team that they are supporting in the registration process so that Riders will not turn back on the course to reach a feed/technical assistance zone.

Any rider doing so will be disqualified. Only within the feed/technical assistance zone itself, a rider may turn back without obstructing other competitors.

ELECTRONIC TIMING SYSTEM

For the event we will have disposable electronic timing for all categories provided by the company Evolution Marketing.

The installation of any awning must be authorized by the Race Director who may outsource the service for the correct arrangement of the awnings by team.










